Subject: Commissioner Districts: 2006 Update

At the Board-Manager Annual Work Session/Retreat, the Board requested this issue be brought before the full Board for consideration. In sequential order, the map updates are:

1. Current Demographics – No Change: If no changes are made, this plan stays in effect.
2. Current Demographics – Realignment #1.
3. Current Demographics – Realignment #2.
4. Current Demographics – Realignment #3.
(You cannot legally consider this option, because it is based on non-census data)
5. Current Demographics – Realignment #4.

A Commissioner requested this item again be placed on the agenda for consideration.

Also, a proposal to possibly request the N.C. General Assembly to give Pender County the sole authority to amend its own voting districts, per census data, may also be considered.

At the April 3, 2006 meeting, Mr. Moore made a motion that this Board go on record as being in favor of redistricting, Mr. Rivenbark seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.
