

PROCLAMATION BY THE PENDER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

**U.S. CONSTITUTION WEEK
SEPTEMBER 17-23, 2006**

Whereas, September 17, 2006 marks the two hundred and nineteenth anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize this magnificent document and the anniversary of its creation; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

Whereas, public law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF PENDER COUNTY that the week of September 17 through 23, 2006 is officially designated as "U.S. Constitution Week" in Pender County; and

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED that in Pender County, North Carolina, our citizens are asked to reaffirm the ideals the Framers of the Constitution had in 1787.
