

CRIMINAL JUSTICE PARTNERSHIP ADVISORY BOARD (CJPP)

DESCRIPTION: The Criminal Justice Partnership Advisory Board (CJPP) is a community advisory board that meets quarterly to review the effectiveness of the programs and assess community needs. The Board, consisting of counselors, court representatives, Assistant District Attorney, Pender County Jail, Probation and Parole, and county government representatives, oversees the N.C. Department of Correction CJPP grant each year. The program sponsors and funds contractual services with sexual offender treatment providers, substances abuse treatment providers, and anger management counselors to serve the court ordered needs of the probation and parole division.

FY 06-07 HIGHLIGHTS: During this fiscal year Chemical Dependence Training Evaluation and Guidance (CDTEG) counseled 83 substance abuse offenders (up from 69 in FY04-05) and Center for The Research and Prevention of Recidivism counseled 12 sexual abuse offenders in an effort to prevent recidivism.

FY 07-08 GOALS: The primary goal is to reduce recidivism; thereby reducing incarceration costs. Counselors work with court personnel to assist offenders in successfully completing their parole and becoming productive members of society.
